Small slide near Little Ellis

Date Sat, 03/25/2023 - 18:00 Activity Skiing

Came across debris of a recent skier-triggered slide near the top of Little Ellis in a small, protected, eastern facing gully around 7,500'. Crown was \sim 3.5-1.5' deep, \sim 35' wide and it ran \sim 150'. Ski tracks were observed near the top of the crown and next to a small hole near the surface \sim 70' from the crown where it looks like someone self extracted. No signal was found with a beacon search and my group felt that the one track from the hole must have been from the same skier as the track near the crown.

There was around 2-3' of heavy new snow at that location.
