Observed multiple D1-1.5 natural dry loose avalanches (and some tiny <u>wind slab</u> pockets under the ridge <u>cornice</u>) that likely occurred during peak warming around 2-3 PM. North/sheltered aspects from ~9- 8.5k held an average of 8+ inches of dry, drifted snow. Early AM to mid-afternoon, very active wind transport followed by tapered winds and a rapid increase in temp.
